# Purpose of Survey

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- To be able to serve parents
- Support students and families
- Strengthen our procedures
- Enhance communication and collaboration between school and home

# Results

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- 7 out of 93 families responded to the survey
- Responses:
  - Agree, Strongly Agree, Disagree, Strongly Disagree, Neutral
  - Yes, No, Maybe

# Results broken down

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- Classification clearly explained: 86% in favor; 14 % neutral
- Special education program clearly explained: 86% in favor; 14 % neutral
- Being a partner in child's IEP: 86%; 14% maybe
- Progress explained and documented: 86% in favor; 14 % neutral
- Education in Least Restrictive Environment: 29% strongly; 57% agree; 14 % neutral

# Result broken down continued

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- Accommodations and modifications discussed at IEP meetings: 86 % Yes, 14% Maybe
- Parent asked about short and long term goal for their child: 72% Yes; 14% No; 14% Maybe
- Special Education parent trainings are available on variety of topics: 43% agree; 15% strongly agree; 43% neutral
- Case Manager is available to address questions: 72% strongly agree; 14% agree, 14% neutral

# Results Continued

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- CST ensures understanding of rights of parents: 72% strongly agree; 14% agree; 14% neutral
- Teachers available to communicate with parents: 72% strongly agree; 14% agree; 14% neutral
- Teachers treat me as a team member: 72% strongly agree; 14% agree; 14% neutral
- Teachers monitor goals and objectives in IEP: 29% strongly agree; 57% agree; 14% neutral

# Results continued

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- Teachers and Administrators who sensitivity to the needs of students and their families: 14% strongly agree; 57% agree; 14% disagree; 14% neutral
- Someone can answer questions: 29% strongly agree; 57% agree; 14% neutral
- School offers parents a variety of ways to communicate with teachers: 29% strongly agree; 57% agree; 14% neutral
- My child seems comfortable in their program: 72% yes 28% no

## Results continued

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- Overall satisfaction of the special education instruction: 29% strongly agree; 57% agree; 14% neutral

# Strengths

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- Partnering with parents in developing IEP for their child
- Discussing accommodations and modifications at the IEP meetings

# Areas to Improve

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- Offer more special education trainings on various topics
- Teachers and administrators will show more sensitivity to the needs of students and their families
